Friendship – I will be kind and polite to everyone I meet

Perseverance – I will keep trying and never give up

Achievement – I will work hard in all that I do

Honesty – I will always tell the truth and be trustworthy

Respect – I will respect people, property and the environment

Responsibility – I will be responsible and reliable

Sustainability – I will help to reduce, recycle and reuse

Compassion – I will be caring and thoughtful towards others

Love – If I do all these things, I can say "I love my neighbour"

Consequences

If I break the rules of the charter, there will be consequences ...

- A verbal warning will be issued explaining what I am doing wrong
- A second verbal warning is issued if my behaviour does not improve
- A third verbal warning means a timeout will be issued and I will lose up to 15 minutes of my time
 - If a 15-minute timeout is issued, my parents will be informed
- Any further serious disregard of the Charter will result in an automatic timeout of a minimum of 15 minutes and the involvement of the Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher
 - My parents will be contacted
- In <u>very serious</u> situations I may be excluded from school for a
 day or longer. If this were to happen then I would be given
 work to do at home. This could happen if I behaved in a very
 irresponsible manner and where my actions have severely
 upset the learning, happiness or safety of others at school.
 Finally the Governors may decide that they do not want me to
 be allowed to go to Birdham School. Nobody would want this
 but it is possible.
- As a church school, there will always be forgiveness and so past mistakes will be 'forgotten' so you can have a clean start.



The Birdham Charter will help to keep me safe and happy at school.
